After completing a Bachelor's degree in Law-Political Science and a Masters in Linguistics at the University of Montpellier, he chose to enhance his knowledge of the German language, culture, and musical and theatrical canon and was accepted to the prestigious Austrian University of Music and Performing Arts of Vienna. He graduated with honors with a major in Musical Theater Direction (Prof. Reto Nickler).

His interest in the future of musical theater also leads him to regularly give masterclasses in the performing arts, and to conduct pedagogical productions together with Opera Fuoco (David Stern), with Luxembourg Philharmonie (Stefan Gehmacher/Pascal Sticklies) and Le Parlement de Musique (Martin Gester) among others.

Benjamin Prins has been laureate of a artistic residency 2019 at the Cité internationale des arts from where he produced the trilogy THE EXPLORERS for the Young audience.

He also completed his 3 years training to become a teacher of the Alexander Technique® (Training Center of Agnès de Brunhoff in Paris).
